HISTORY/MISSION STATEMENT

The New York State Hospitality & Tourism Association (NYSH&TA) officially incorporated its scholarship fund into an Education Foundation in 1999. In a show of appreciation to Fred England and his late wife Gertrude's longtime involvement and dedication to the scholarship program, the Foundation voted to change its name in May 2001. It is now called the Fred and Gertrude England Hospitality Education Foundation. Its mission statement is to assist in the educational development of hospitality students by offering individual scholarships to member employees and/or their dependents.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

The Foundation's scholarship funds come from a variety of sources. NYSH&TA holds an annual Saratoga Summer Fundraiser each summer, as well as a Silent Auction during the Association's Annual Conference, with proceeds benefiting the scholarship program.

***Louis N. Ventresca Scholarship Award**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY

COLLEGE STUDENTS:

- ◆ Scholarships are available to employees OR dependents of employees of a NYSH&TA member.
- ◆ Students must have completed 15 college credits.
- ◆ Students must be majoring in the hospitality field.
- ◆ Students must maintain a minimum 2.50 grade point average (GPA).

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:

- ◆ High school students must be at least in the second semester of the second year of the Lodging Management Program (LMP) and working towards certification.
- ◆ Student internships, as required in the LMP, must be or have been with a NYSH&TA member.
- ◆ Students must intend to major in the hospitality field in college.
- ◆ Students must maintain a minimum 2.50 grade point average (GPA).

PAYMENTS

SCHOLARSHIP:

- ◆ Full-time students receive \$1,500 per semester for a maximum of \$6,000.
- ◆ Part-time students receive \$750 per semester for a maximum of \$6,000.
- ◆ If part-time student becomes full-time student, then the \$1,500 per semester begins for a total of \$6,000 per student.
- ◆ Scholarship payments begin the semester following the formal presentation of the awards and are paid directly to the educational institution.

LOUIS N. VENTRESCA SCHOLARSHIP:

The Louis N. Ventresca Scholarship Award is named after the Foundation's first Chairman of the Board, Louis N. Ventresca, and is recognized with additional funds.

- ◆ Full-time students receive \$1,750 per semester for a maximum of \$7,000.
- ◆ Part-time students receive \$875 per semester for a maximum of \$7,000.
- ◆ If part-time student becomes full-time student, then the \$1,750 per semester begins for a total of \$7,000 per student.
- ◆ Scholarship payments begin the semester following the formal presentation of the awards and are paid directly to the educational institution.

APPLICATION

STEP 2: Provide a one to two page letter of **Personal Description and Intent** (*on a separate sheet of paper*).

STEP 3: Enclose *three* **Letters of Recommendation**. (*One letter must be from a NYSH&TA member*).

STEP 4: Enclose **Current Transcripts** or have them forwarded by your educational institution.

STEP 5: **Sign Application** and send to address below.

Please clearly print or type all the information requested. To be eligible to enter the 2009 scholarship competition, your application must be submitted by *April 17, 2009*. Any applications received after the due date cannot be given consideration. **All information provided is confidential and will be used solely by the Foundation in making its selection.**
